



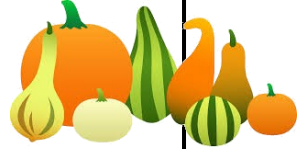

Egg Packing Station Affordable Housing News...

After a series of disappointments the Parish Council have now found a new prospective development partner, for the Egg Packing Station site. Discussions are currently being held with the Addington Fund who are a housing charity providing housing for Land Workers in need. Representatives of the Addington Fund are visiting the Egg Packing site and discussions on the cost of the potential development will follow that. Once viable proposals are put in place the Parish Council will be able to pursue an option to purchase the site. Eden District Council has confirmed that there is no adverse legal and housing policy implications of the proposed links between the Parish Council and the Addington Fund. However the award to pursue the site purchase and the remediation grants are conditional on being able to demonstrate viable fully funded proposals.

Police Reports...

At the September 2022 Parish Council meeting the Police in attendance reported several antisocial behaviour incidents over the summer in the parish, from smashing bottles through to drunk and dangerous driving. The Police will continue to pursue antisocial issues and take legal action when needed.
