Egg Packing Station Affordable Housing News...

It was reported at the March 2023 meeting of the Parish Council that Castle and Coast Housing Association will now be taking the lead in the affordable housing project on the site of the Egg Packing Station. Castles and Coasts Housing Association will be submitting a grant application to purchase and remediate the egg packing station site in the coming weeks. The Parish Council will be transferring all responsibility for the housing project to them in the near future.

Eden Bridge Maintenance and Volunteers Welcome to help...

Members of the Parish Council and Parish volunteers will be filling in pot holes at Eden Bridge car park on Wednesday 26th April at 7 pm. The Parish Council would welcome more volunteers to help them and to bring with them shovels, wheel barrows, work gloves and strong footwear. The Parish Council will be ordering in bags of hardcore and hiring a wacker plate to carry out the work. Please turn up on the day if you can give a few hours of your time.

Crimes Recently Reported in the Ward of Lazonby...

Overnight between 10th and 11th January a Land Rover was moved in a yard in North Dykes, believed to be attempted theft.

On the 11th February a driver was arrested for drug driving in Lazonby.

Overnight between 19th and 20th February a car on Meadow Close was damaged by paint thrown over it and a tyre slashed.

At 2:30am on 23rd February a white flat bed van was seen in Great Salkeld and Lazonby with men going into people's gardens. CCTV enquiries were conducted to try and identify the vehicle however the Police were unable to. There was nothing reported as stolen.

At 3 am on 26th February a van pulled up outside a property in Great Salkeld and a male got out and went towards the property but got spooked when the dog started barking.

On 25th February very pushy males in an Irish plated vehicle were going door to door asking to pressure wash driveways. Details of vehicle and person were obtained by the police.

Around 2 pm on the 26th February a bicycle which had been left chained to a fence in Lazonby was stolen.
