Affordable Housing News...

Gordon Nicolson, on behalf of the Parish Council, had a productive meeting recently with Castles and Coasts Housing Association and Westmorland & Furness Council Housing Officers. The meeting was arranged to revive and update the grant application to purchase and remediate the Egg Packing Station site. The Council and Castles and Coasts wish to continue working with the Parish Council to develop the site for up to 7 affordable houses. The Council are finalising their procedures for consideration and determination of significant grants from the Affordable Housing Fund. It is expected that a joint grant application would be determined by the Council's new Investment Board. It was confirmed that the development proposals are compliant with the aims and other provisions of the Affordable Housing Fund. The grant application will need to be resubmitted in the new format approved by the Council Cabinet. **Please see the Parish Council Minutes for more details.**

Lazonby Fire Station...

As you will know there was a fire at the station In February and the Fire engine was temporarily rehoused at Bells of Lazonby. The Fire Service are very thankful for their help. The Fire Engine returned to the station at the beginning of March.

Current Issues being Resolved and Projects in the Parish

- The Parish Council has now carried out a maintenance survey of all of the footway lights are around the village and the lights needing repair are being reported.
- *The Parish Council are still updating their report regarding footway issues that need to be dealt with within the parish which will be given to Highways but as it is a lot of work the Councillors are doing it in stages.*
- BARN is continues to develop their broadband services in the village and are currently looking into rights of way for their fibre optic cables and have had several meetings recently to progress the project.
- *The Parish Council are currently identifying areas in the parish that could be part of the County's Planting for Pollinators Project.*
- The Parish Council are hoping to organise a 'Village Tidy Up' day in the near future and would welcome volunteers from the local community to help.
- The Parish Council have been identifying potholes in the village and these will be reported to Highways, who will be visiting the area with their 'jetpatcher' so let's hope they visit the parish soon.

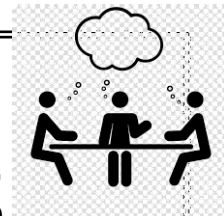
