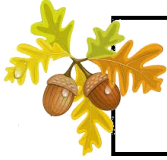
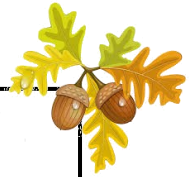

Egg Packing Station Affordable Housing News...

The Parish Council have met with representatives from the Addington Fund, who have also visited the site. So far they are happy with the Housing Development project and happy to continue discussions. They will also be reporting back to their Trustees so the next few weeks will be very important in the progression of the project. The Parish Council will be seeking a grant to buy and remediate the site, repair the collapsed wall, re-route the drains and make it all ready to build out, which the Addington Fund will be responsible for. This is just a facilitation position for the Parish Council and they will have no responsibility or liability in the future. There is still plenty of issues to decide and agree on but the future of the project is looking bright again.



Issues Being Currently Resolved in the Parish...

- The sunken tarmac in Fiddlers lane and the broken gully have now been repaired.
- The broken rail and broken flag stone near the bench by the Old school which was damaged by a car is still in the process of being repaired.
- A coping stone on a wall near the Church is going to be replaced/repared by the County Council.
- The County Council program has now been started regarding dealing with the state of the footpaths including the issue of dropped kerbs for wheelchair users. It is all to be completed by the end of March 2023.
- The Parish Council are still looking into collecting donations for the use of Eden Bridge Car Park.
