## Egg Packing Station Affordable Housing News...

The project remains positive. The Addington Fund Board of Trustees are still to meet due to the last meeting date being cancelled. Reporting to the Trustees is very important in the progression of the project. Eden District Council and the Vendors of the site are being kept updated on progress in preparation to take the project forward.

## The Local Government Reorganisation News (LGR)...

Work across County to put in place the two new Unitary Authorities is picking up pace as everything needs to be in place for the 1st April 2023. Eden will be part of the Westmoreland and Furness Council, with Voreda House in Penrith being one of the main Council headquarters buildings for the new authority. They have recruited a Chief Executive and a Director of Finance but they still need to recruit the Chief Legal and Monitoring Officer by December 2022. The Budget Consultation for the two new Authorities will be set for February/March 2023.

## Issues Being Currently Resolved in the Parish...

- The broken rail has been repaired but the broken flag stone is still to be repaired near the bench by the Old School after being damaged by a car.
- A coping stone on a wall near the Church has now been repaired
- The Parish Council are still working on the possibility of collecting donations for the use of Eden Bridge Car Park but the issue of collecting donations are proving to be difficult.
- The Parish Council are investigating the possibility of creating a warm space in the Parish for this Winter.
- The footpath between Eden Bridge is complete and the invoice has been received from County Council to finalise the payment.

## Sustainable Warmth Cumbria Grants

Cumbrian district councils have secured funding to run the Sustainable Warmth Local Authority Delivery Scheme - aiming to install energy saving measures into over 1,300 homes across Cumbria.

If your household income is below £30,000 and your home has a low energy performance you could be eligible for a government grant up to £25,000 towards insulation and low carbon heating measures, like heat pumps and Solar Panels.

The funding grant is even available for private landlords to apply for qualifying tenants.

## **Disabled facilities grants available....**

This grant is also available for elderly persons who are struggling with mobility. The aim of this grant is to help maintain people's independence and safety in their own home for as long as possible.

Example of works carried out under grant include:

- ☐ Stair lifts
- ☐ Level access shower facilities
- ☐ Ramps
- ☐ Making the property wheelchair accessible
- ☐ Specialist toilet facilities

For consideration of a grant, you need a recommendation from an Occupational Therapist. To do this you can contact Adult Social Care and request an Occupational Therapist to visit your home to assess your needs, by telephone on 0300 3033249 or by emailing [customer-services-north@cumbria.gov.uk](mailto:customer-services-north@cumbria.gov.uk)

Adult Disabled facilities grants are means tested, in certain circumstances, depending on the extent of the work required.
