

The Parish Council are also looking at having Lazonby signs made out of sandstone. This is all still to be decided and the cost worked out before a final decision is made.

# Footpath between Eden Bridge and Lazonby & District Swimming Pool News...

County Councillor Hilary Carrick has managed to secured the majority of the funding towards the footpath between Eden Bridge and Lazonby & District Swimming Pool which is fantastic news after many years of trying to get the footpath put in. This will mean there will be £80,000 towards the project. small amount of match funding is still needed to be able to complete project of approximately the £20,000 which Members of the Parish Council are looking into. There are a few areas on the paths route that still need to be finalised such as asking for landowners permission. It will be an adoptable that Cumbria County SO Council will be able to maintain it in the future.
