



Egg Packing Station Affordable Housing News...

It was reported at the February 2023 meeting of the Parish Council that one of the existing Housing Association partners had pulled out of the housing project as they felt that the location was too far away from their usual service area. However, another more local Housing Association has expressed an interest in partnering with the Addington Fund who will be responsible for the building of the houses and managing them. So now meetings are being held to look at how to progress the project again. There is now a deadline for the end of March to secure funding to remediate the site and purchase the land.

The Local Government Reorganisation News (LGR)...

This April 2023 sees the start of our new Local Authority now called the Westmorland and Furness Council. They are hoping for a seamless transition from the existing Council structures to the new ones. Operational staff are being transferred and contracts carried over for services like waste collection.



Issues Being Currently Resolved in the Parish...

- Maintenance repairs to the footways in the village are to be carried out in the coming months.
- The broken flag stone is still to be repaired near the bench by the Old School after being damaged by a car.
- A coping stone on a wall near the Church was found not to have been repaired although the Parish Council were told it had so that is back on the list for repairs.
- The Parish Council have been in touch with other Parish Councils to ask how they collect car parking donations to see if any of them can be used at Eden Bridge Car Park.
- The 30 mile an hour signs have now been cleaned after being vandalised
- The Parish Council have reported water and mud on some of the surfaces of local roads in the area to Highways.



Parish Council Elections in May 2023

The Parish Council will be looking for new Parish Councillors to join the Parish Council this May because several existing Parish Councillors will be retiring from their roles after many years of dedicated service to the local community.

It is very important that the Parish has a Parish Council to continue to be the local community voice on issues such as planning, highways, County and Nationwide consultations etc. As well as carry on much needed parish projects and deal with local parish maintenance issues.

Boards and Parish Council Website which will include how parishioners can join the Parish Council to make up the ten Members needed. If more than ten prospective Members come forward then it will go to an election.




Your Parish Council Continues to Work for the Local Community ...
